Library

The college library is well-equipped with a wide range of learning resources that support the overall development of both students and faculty. It offers access Internet including variety of materials, textbooks, reference books and periodicals etc. Currently, the library boasts a collection of 13,500 textbooks and reference books covering various subjects. The library has subscription to two leading newspapers: Assam Tribune (English) and Asomiya Pratidin (Assamese). The library utilizes SOUL 3.0 for automating its resources. Partial automation has been completed and work on the remaining resources is currently underway. The college has access to the N-LIST program, offering a wide array of e-resources. Students can borrow books using the library cards issued to them by the library. A Book Bank has been introduced in the library with the generous support of the college alumni. The primary objective of this initiative is to provide essential academic resources to students in need, allowing them to retain the borrowed books until the completion of their respective examinations.

Library Facilities & Services

- ➤ **Library User Orientation** Carried out to introduce new users to the library and familiarize them with the various services it offers.
- ➤ Circulation service- HS and UG students can borrow 1 and 2 books respectively for 15 days. Faculty members can borrow 5 books for 180 days and other staff can borrow 3 books for 180 days.
- **Reprographic Service** The library offers photocopying services in the circulation section at a standard rate.
- ➤ **Library Notice Board** Users can access important announcements regarding new library services and facilities, as well as key notices related to the college.
- Access to E-resources- Access to online e-resources through N-LIST consortia and NDLI.
- ➤ **Periodicals and News papers-**Daily newspaper, monthly journal and magazines are subscribed for students and faculty members as well as non teaching staff.
- ➤ Access question papers- The library provides previous years' examination question papers for reference and consultation.
- ➤ Book Bank Facility- The Book Bank facility is available to economically disadvantaged and for differently-abled students in accordance with the library's Book Bank guidelines.

Library Rules

- All students are required to wear the college uniform when visiting the library.
- All personal belongings, except essential items such as a wallet, mobile phone, notebook, and library card must be deposited at the property counter.
- Every member must sign the gate register at the entrance.
- Every user must produce their library card at the time of borrowing books.
- Two books are issued to the students in degree course and one book is issued to the students in Higher Secondary Course.
- Books are issued for 15(fifteen) days only. A fine of Rs. 2.00 per day will be charged for each book kept beyond the due date.
- Members should get their books/documents checked at the check point while leaving the library.
- Books that are lost, damaged or defaced in any way must be replaced or compensated for by the borrower.
- Mobile phones should be kept on silent or vibration mode while in the library.
- Users must maintain silence in the library.
- Edible items are strictly prohibited inside the library.
- The library card is non-transferable, and any loss must be reported to the librarian immediately in writing. A fine of ₹50 will be charged for the re-issuance of a Library Borrower's Card.
- Anyone who violates the rules and regulations of the library would be liable to lose the privilege of library membership.

Safety and Security Measures in the college campus:

Protected Campus-The College is well protected with boundary walls covering the whole campus; the college also has security guards for 24 fours of service. The College has CCTV cameras and it also provides I Cards to the students.

Internal Complaint Committee-The College has constituted an Internal Complain Committee to address any kind of harassment against any employee for students. The college maintains zero to legation policy in this case.

- ❖ A student who has passed 12th standard or equivalent examination in any stream from a recognized institution.
- ❖ Admission to the FYUGP will be based on the preference on the disciplines to be chosen as Major and Minor.
- Admission to a Programme or Major will depend on the availability of the subject and intake capacity of a department and also on the criteria set by the concerned departments.
- ❖ No student shall be eligible for admission to a Programme in any discipline under the FYUGP unless s/he fulfills the pre-requisites of courses as fixed by the university.
- ❖ The students have to check their eligibility by verifying (10+2) subject combination before taking admission in a particular subject under FYUGP. The Link for the prerequisite verifier is given below:

Registration in ABC (Academic Bank of Credits):

❖ The GU-FYUGP is directly connected to the ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) as notified by the UGC. All credits a student earns at the end of an examination in GU-FYUGP, will be deposited in the ABC by the university. As such, it is mandatory that a student under GU-FYUGP register for the ABC as notified by the regulatory agencies. For undergraduate programme, prior to admission, candidates should get their Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID by registering in the following portal:

[Students must obtain the 12 digit ABC ID through the Digi Locker platform. Aadhaar Card is mandatory for all admitted students as it will be required for all purposes like the creation of ABC, Registration with University, etc. Those who do not have Aadhaar Card must avail it within two three weeks from the date of admission.]
