MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING By and Between Lakhipur College, Lakhipur, Goalpara, Assam And Dudhnoi College, Goalpara, Assam

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into Lakhipur College, a higher educational institution located at Lakhipur, Goalpara, Assam and by Dudhnoi College, Goalpara, Assam. Lakhipur College and Dudhnoi College are each hereinafter also referred to as "Institution" and collectively as "Institutions".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Institutions are linked by common academic, cultural and regional interests;

WHEREAS, the Institutions wish to enable cooperation and exchange in all academic areas of mutual interest for the benefit of the respective Institutions and to promote the development of joint studies, activities and other educational programs of mutual interest;

WHEREAS, this MOU supports the Lakhipur College Mission and Dudhnoi College Mission;

THEREFORE, in consideration of the relationship to be established and the covenants set forth herein, the Institutions agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Area and Scope of MOU

1.01 <u>Area of Cooperation</u> Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either institution and may include, but are not limited to:

- Joint teaching, research or cultural activity
- Mobility of faculty and students between institutions
- Staff professional development
- Sharing or creation of educational materials and resources
- Joint and articulated certificate courses (add on courses)

1.02 <u>Scope of Cooperation</u> Any specific activity developed under this MOU shall be detailed in subsequent agreement, signed by each institution's authorized signatory, which will describe the scope of the proposed activity, intended outcomes, budget, and responsible departments or individuals.

1.03 All activities shall be subject to the availability of funds and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives.

ARTICLE 2

Procedures

2.01 Liaisons In order to carry out and fulfill the aim of this MOU, each institution will appoint appropriate persons at each of their campuses to coordinate the development of collaborative activities. Through these contact persons, any of the Institutions may initiate proposals for activities under this MOU. The contact persons will additionally be responsible for the evaluation of activities under this MOU according to the practices of their respective Institutions. Any notice to the Institutions under the MOU must be in writing and shall be deemed given when received by the Institution's designated contact person.

ARTICLE 3

Term and Termination

3.01 <u>Term</u> This MOU shall take effect upon signature by the Institutions ("Effective Date") and, unless earlier terminated, will continue for a period of 5 (five) years from the Effective Date.

3.02 Extension This MOU may be extended by mutual agreement of the Institutions, which must be reduced to writing and signed by the Institutions.

3.03 Termination This MOU may be terminated at any time by any Institutions upon written notice to the other Institutions. Any supplemental agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU will not automatically terminate with the termination of this MOU, and any student then enrolled in a program created by such supplemental agreement shall be permitted to complete that program under the terms and agreements of that supplemental agreement. **3.04 Amendment** This MOU may be amended at any time by any of the Institutions upon mutual consent, which must be reduced to writing and signed by the Institutions.

ARTICLE 4
Miscellaneous
4.01 Resolution of Disputes This MOU is based on the common trust and good faith of the Institutions. In case of disputes, the parties, through the liaisons designated in Section 2.01 of this MOU, shall make a good faith effort to obtain an amicable resolution.

Whereas





All notices regarding this agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail postage prepaid or by courier, at the address as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner. Any such notices shall be deemed received when actually delivered if personal delivery or three days after delivered to an overnight or express mail facility, if delivered through post.

8. Governing Law

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the law of the republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Guwahati/Chennai.

9. Commercials

It is a Non Commercial MoU between ICT Academy and LAKHIPUR COLLEGE, ASSAM. The College will provide the infrastructure and space to host the Faculty Development Programs at their premises.

10. Arbitration

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between the parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this agreement either party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT Academy, the other to be appointed by LAKHIPUR COLLEGE, ASSAM, and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties.

The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Guwahati/Chennai.




