Instructions

- 1. Admission processes of Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) will be conducted through the SAMARTGH e-Gov web-portal of the Department of Education, Government of Assam.
- 2. From the subjects included in the Core Subject, students are requested to select three subjects of their choice as Core Subjects. However, students should check the Prerequisites, Requirements and Constraints.
- 3. There is no limitation on the choice of three Core Subjects in Arts. Arts students can give priority to MIL/ Other Language/ Social Science.
- 4. Of the three subjects selected as Core Subjects, one will be converted to Major and the other two to Minor in the third semester.
- 5. If seats are exhausted on the date of admission in the subject requested as First Core Subject through SAMARTH e-Gov Suite, students will have to take only the subject of their second or third choice as First Core Subject.
- 6. In the case of Common Course, students have to choose VAC, MDC, AEC, SEC. There is no alternative here.

The college was shifted to its present campus on 05-12-1984 at Ward No 2 of Lakhipur Town under 38, Goalpara west LAC. Lakhipur College, affiliated to Guahati University offers two years Higher Secondary courses in Arts and 3 years semester system degree courses in Arts. Since inception, the college has been working hard for spreading higher education among the masses of the Socio-Eco-Edu-culturally backward areas. In its thirty two years of existence, the college reached the present status. The college obtained UGC affiliation under 2(f) and 12 (B) on 14-12-2004. Facilities of Lakhipur College

Library

The college has a library which is rich in learning resources required for overall development of the learners and the faculty members. The users can access a variety of resources comprising textbooks, reference books, periodicals etc. The library has a total collection of 13,000 textbooks and reference books till date covering different subjects. The library has subscriptions to two leading newspapers namely Assam Tribune (English) and Asomiya Pratidin (Assamese). The library has SOUL (an integrated Library Management Software) for the automation of the library resources. Partial automation of the library is completed and automation of the rest is in progress. Recently, for accessing the e-resources through N-LIST (National Library and Information services Infrastructure of Scholarly Content), subscription to N-LIST has been done and additionally subscription has been made to The Heritage, a multilingual research journal in Indology. Students borrow books against their library cards provided by the library. It is to be noted that a book bank has been introduced in the library with the help of the alumni of the college. The very purpose of the book bank is to lend books to the needy students allowing them to keep the books they borrow till the concerned exam is over. The college is situated in an area which is socially economically and educationally underdeveloped. There are a lot number of students who belong to below poverty line. In a view to assist and help those students, the book bank has been introduced. The library remains open from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. The teacher and the students of the college do not only use the library regularly, they use the library optimally, availing all the facilities.

Library Facilities & Services

- ➤ **Library User Orientation** The library orientation program is carried out for new users aware to the library and services provided by the library.
- ➤ Circulation service- HS and UG students can borrow 1 book and 2books respectively for 15 days, faculties can borrow 5 books for 180 days and other staff can borrow 3 books for 180 days.
- **Reprographic Service** The library has also the facility of photo coping in the library circulation section at normal charge.
- ➤ **Library Notice Board** Users can get the important notices about the library new services & facilities and also important notices about the college.
- > Access to E-resources- Access to online e-resources through INFLIBNET & N-LIST consortia and NDLI
- ➤ **Periodicals and News papers-**Daily news paper, monthly journal and magazines are subscribed for students and faculties.
- ➤ Access question papers- The library provides the question papers of previous years final exam for consultation.
- ➤ Book Bank Facility-Book bank facility is given to poor and differently able students according to Book Bank rules of the library.

Library Rules

- Every student must come to the library with college uniform.
- All personal belongings except the essential stationary items e.g., wallet, mobile phone, note book and library card will have to deposit in the property counter.
- Every member must sign the gate register available at the entrance.
- Every user must produce their library card at the time of borrowing books.
- Two books are issued to the students to degree course and one book is issued to the students of Higher Secondary Course.
- Books are issued for 15(fifteen) days only. A fine of Rs. 1.00 per day will be charged for each book kept beyond the due date.
- Members should get their books/documents checked at the check point while leaving the library.
- Books lost, torn or defected in anyway have to be replaced/ compensation paid by the borrower.
- Keep mobile phones in mute mode or vibration mode

- Users must maintain silence in the library.
- No eatable items are allowed in the library.
- The library card is not transferable and its loss must be reported immediately in writing to the librarian and fine of Rs.50/- will be charged for re-issue of a Library Borrower's Card.
- Anyone who violates the rules and regulations of the library would be liable to lose the privilege of library membership.

Safety and Security Measures in the college campus:

Protected Campus- The College is well protected with boundary walls covering the whole campus; the college also has security guards for 24 fours of service. The College has CCTV cameras and it also provides I Cards to the students.

Internal Complain Committee- The College has constituted an Internal Complain Committee to address any kind of harassment against any employee for students. The college maintains zero toleration policy in this case.

Women Cell – The College has a women cell to address any kind of women issues as well t take initiatives for overall upliftment of the women members of the college, also the women community around the college campus.

Grievance Cell and anti-ragging Cell – The college has several complain boxes in the campus; also it has established these cells for addressing any kind of issues faced by the students. The members of these Cells provide counseling to the students and help them to get rid from their personal as well as educational stresses.

Care Rooms

The College has common room facilities along with washrooms for both male and female students. The College has a baby care room for the parent-students.

Canteen

The college has a canteen that provides various snacks and other food items to students, teachers, employees and visitors at reasonable prices.

Career Guidance Cell

The College has a Career Guidance to provide information regarding higher study options and careers and also to provide basic information about opportunities for self-employment and entrepreneurship and support system available.

LITERARY ACTIVITIES AND PUBLICATIONS

The College publishes annual college magazine for shaping the literary and other creative interests of the students and teachers alike. Articles, creative write-ups, reviews as well as achievements of educational, cultural, social and sports activities of students and teachers of the college are published in this annual Magazine. Moreover every department has their own departmental wall magazines. Several departments

publish Books written by the students.

HOME ASSIGNMENTS AND STUDENT SEMINARS

Students of several departments are required to submit home assignments and participate in student seminars on topics that are allotted from the syllabus of the concerned semester in which a student is studying.

Yoga

The College has appointed Yoga Teacher for teaching the students practical knowledge about Yoga and for the physical development of the students.

Field

There are two playgrounds in the college campus, one is approximately 1.28 acres. It is named a Late Gopal Pandey memorial Playground, The other playground is 2.21 acres. Students can play different games like cricket, football, volleyball etc.

Sports and Cultural Activities:

The college provides enough opportunities for sports, games and cultural activities. Sports competitions are organized regularly every year for students. Students are trained with special care for taking part in Zonal, Inter-Zonal, state and National level competitions organized by the various government and non-governmental organizations. There is a big permanent open stage having a large space in his front side in the college campus. This open stage is used to organize various cultural and academic activities. There is also a small open stage attached with one of the playgrounds. Besides, there is a multipurpose hall namely LB- and LB-ll which is also used for many other cultural and academic events. Besides, the college provides the students with cricket bat, football, valley equipment, Badminton racket etc. Additionally, the college provides some traditional attire like Hajong dress etc. to the students for participation in the cultural events.

Extension Activities

In order to develop social aptitude of the students, various extension education programs are organized from time to time in the nearby areas of the institution specially in the adopted villages and schools of the College. These activities are primarily facilitated, coordinated and monitored by the IQAC of the College.

Excursion and Field Trips

Several departments organize these programs and activities for the students. For some subjects, these activities are part of the co-curricular activities. Faculty members from respective departments accompany the student groups during such programs

Bridge Course

Several departments of the College organizes introductory sessions in the form of bridge courses in the

nearby schools for the students of HS final year, not only for giving them a broad overview of the institution, but also to help them understand the curriculum and broad perspectives of the subject.

NSS

The NSS unit of Lakhipur College, Lakhipur started functioning in 2022 under the initiative of Mr. Imran Mozid, Assistant Professor, Department of English. The unit starts functioning under Gauhati University and has been a self financing unit since its inception. The unit has undertaken several social service activities around the vicinity of the College.

1. Facilities:

- Classroom Facilities: The classrooms are equipped with black board with proper desk and bench facilities. The room also have proper lighting facility like LED bulb and fan.
- ➤ **Library**:There is a library in the department. There are about 350 numbers of books in the departmental library which includes both text books and references.
- Computer: A desktop is available in the department for performing various official works.

Activities: Students of the undergraduate Honours program are required to presentseminar talks and home assignments in every Semester on topics included in their respective syllabus. Field works are conducted every year for the 6^{th} semester U.G. students. Students are engaged indepartmental activities like publication of wall magazine. There is ample scope for the students toparticipate in differentsocio-cultural activities. Entrance preparation had been organized by the department for the students in the last academic session.

Achievements: The student of Assamese Department participates in wall magazine competition that is organised by lakhipur college. The Assamese department has won 2nd and 3rd position in Wall Magazine competition which was held in the year 2023 and 2024 respectively. Every year the student of Assamese Department participates in cultural rally during the college week. In 2023 and 2024, the Department of Assamese won the 1st and 2nd position respectively in cultural procession. The department of Assamese have organized workshop on hajong folk dance. From this workshop program, the students have benefited by gaining dancing qualities among themselves.
